Print and Performance in Dickens's Sketches by Boz

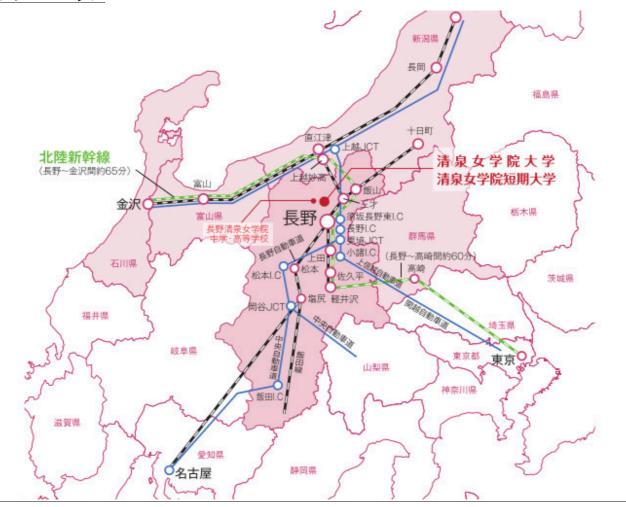

"What inexhaustible food for speculation, do the streets of London afford!" exclaims Dickens in *Sketches by Boz*. These short miscellaneous sketches of London life in the 1830s did not start life as a series: Dickens tells us that, "their original appearance" was "in different periodicals", reaching different readerships. *Sketches by Boz* is fascinated by the paper ephemera of which it formed, on its first outing anyway, a part. The *Morning Chronicle*, in which some of these sketches first appeared, is one of the newspapers hawked on the London streets in the sketch, 'Early Coaches': "you are assailed on all sides with shouts of 'Times, gen'lm'n, Times,' 'Here's Chron – Chron,' 'Herald, ma'am,' 'Highly interesting murder, gen'lm'n,' 'Curious case o' promise, ladies." *Sketches* finds print strewn around everywhere it goes. From the law student's sitting room in Gray's-inn-square, with its "strange chaos [of] ...caricatures, albums, invitation-cards ...[and] cardboard drawings," to the women's ward in Newgate Jail, where, "texts from Scripture" are "scattered about the room in scraps", to the advertising "squibs" nailed up in the streets, paper is discovered everywhere in this text. But print does not necessarily signify reading in *Sketches*. Instead, it seems entwined with visuality and performance. Dickens's "little" people in *Sketches by Boz* experience print not as informational, two-dimensional, and ephemeral like the newspaper, but rather as one medium in a multi-media virtual London that was growing in scale and complexity alongside the built city.

"Pavement Art and Impermanent Fiction"

This paper explores the implications of "His Brown Paper Parcel," a short story that Dickens wrote in 1862 when Wilkie Collins failed to deliver his contribution for *Somebody's Luggage*, a collection of short tales published in the Christmas number of *All the Year Round* that year. On the surface, this story is an entertainment, a relatively insubstantial and undemanding read. The main part of the tale is narrated by a pavement artist: one who makes his living through drawing images with chalk on sidewalks – a highly ephemeral form of art. I ask why Dickens should have chosen to write a story about such a figure – a story itself as ephemeral, in many ways – given the context of its publication – as an image chalked on a paving slab? To answer this, I look at the whole context of this genre of artistic expression – or this way of life, and the showmanship involved – in C19th London. I explore the issues of execution and performance; originality and derivation; display and cliché, exhibition and publics that are thereby raised. Finally, I turn back to Dickens's concerns as a writer in the early 1860s, and suggest why this apparently slight tale can be seen as dramatizing a number of issues that were especially preoccupying to him – not least in the context of transatlantic reception of his shorter work. In other words, I will be considering the correspondence between erasable art, discardable fiction, and the circulation of literature in both print form and in performance.

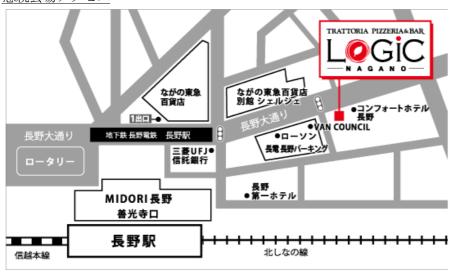
